Re: **Immediate Report - Receipt of Interim Injunction**

This report is a continuation of the Company's report dated February 17, 2020 (ref. No. 2020-01-013990) concerning the decision of the Haifa Municipality not to renew the temporary permit granted Gadiv Petrochemical Industries Ltd (“Gadiv”) under the Business Licensing Law for the transport of materials through an underground pipeline between Gadiv and the port (“the Permit”).

The Company announces that as part of the petition filed by Gadiv, the court has decided that further to an application agreed between the parties, which is acceptable to the Ministry for Environmental Protection, an interim injunction was issued whereby until the hearing on the petition for an interim order and until a decision is handed down, the Permit will remain valid that was meant to expire on February 29, 2020.

The hearing on the petition for an interim order has been set for March 9, 2020.
